You may check the status of your Harvard Law School application. This feature will allow you to monitor the status of your file at your convenience.

Explain any questionable points in your previous statements. Actually, no more than The one exception to this requirement is if you completed the foreign work through a study-abroad, consortium, or exchange program sponsored by a US or Canadian institution, and the work is clearly indicated as such on the home campus transcript. While your transcript and test scores are important, this is where we get to hear directly from you about your candidacy. Probably you already know that one of the admission requirements is submitting special essays which are called the Harvard law essay prompts. Andrew C. He was admitted to Harvard on his first attempt at applying “ in the very first round of applicants. Look at the first question: Think about any legal issue you know about that has relevance to your future studies. Interests: do not write all your interests, just say about your favorite legal interests which are related to what you will do at Harvard. You may be prompted to choose a time period from a list. There are the general requirements: grades, LSAT scores, recommendation letters, and the elusive element of luck. The personal statement is intended as an opportunity to give the Admissions Committee a better sense of who you are as a person and as a potential student and graduate of Harvard Law School. Any information that you believe to be relevant to your application is appropriate. The Law School Personal Statement Prompts: Tips For Success Here is the general description of the law school personal statement prompts for you to keep in mind while writing your essay. Here they are: State and describe any legal issue in your region or the world and provide your solution to address it. In the early stages and want to brainstorm ideas? If you completed any postsecondary work outside the US including its territories or Canada, you must use this service for the evaluation of your foreign transcripts. We strongly recommend that at least one letter of recommendation come from an academic source. The personal statement is a very short piece of your self-presentation, resembling a resume.
